Town of Ashford, New York Local Law No. 1 of the Year 1975

A local law designating highways within the Town of Ashford upon which snowmobile travel is permitted.

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Ashford. New York as follows:

Section I: Definitions: The terms, words and phrases used in this local law shall have the same meaning as such terms, words and phrases as defined in Section 21.05 of the New York State Parks and Recreation Law. Whenever the work Town is used herein, it shall mean the Town of Ashford, New York.

Section II: Designation of Highways: The following highways located within the Town are hereby designated as highways upon which snowmobile travel is permitted:

Section III: State Law Controls: Notwithstanding the designation by the Town of highways upon which snowmobile travel is permitted, the operation of snowmobiles upon such highways shall be subject to the provisions of Articles 21, 25 and 27 of the New York State Parks and Recreation Law, as the same now exists or may hereafter be amended, and to any and all other laws of the State of New York concerning ownership and operation of snowmobiles.

Section IV: Separability: If any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision or section of this Local Law shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such portion of this Local Law shall be deemed separate and distinct from the remainder of this Local Law and such judgment shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this Local Law.

Section V: Effective Date: This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon it's being filed in accordance with the provisions of Section 27 of the New York State Municipal Home Rule Law, **provided however**, that no snowmobile shall be operated upon the designated highways until such time as such designated highways have been identified by markers in accordance with the provisions of Article 25 of the New York State Parks and Recreation Law.
