2 Electronics per household (tv, computers, etc.)

can be brought to Town Building on Fox Valley Road

4 passenger car tires per household

Tires must be brought to the Town Building on Fox Valley Road,

FROM 8 A.M. - 2 P.M.**

WILL PICKUP:

Couches • Chairs • Mattresses • Box Springs
Batteries • Appliances with this restriction:

*NO Refrigerators, Freezers
or Air Conditioners*

Coiled Barbed Wire • Items Bundled
in 4' lengths

ITEMS MUST NOT WEIGH MORE THAN 70 LBS.
Etc. (Small items must be in durable containers)
*Each resident will be responsible for keeping all
items packaged as required.*

WILL NOT PICKUP:

Ashes • Refrigerators • Freezers
Air Conditioners Propane Tanks • Paint in Cans
Unapproved Construction Waste • Garbage
Used Oil • Dead Animals or Animal Waste
Brush • Hazardous Waste • Chemicals
Fluorescent Bulbs • NO Vehicle Fuel Tanks
Electronics of any kind
