MAILBOXES...

A mailbox is an allowed infringement on the right-of-way. When such a box is too low or too far out on the right-of-way, they are a hazard to traffic and may be hit by snowplows. Municipalities are not responsible for any damage done to mailboxes.

SNOW ON THE RIGHT-OF-WAY....

As stated in the Vehicle and Traffic Law Section 1219 it is prohibited to push or drop anything including snow in the roadway or right-of-way. Anyone doing so is subject to fines and or penalties. If such a material causes an accident the person responsible is liable for damages.
